<p>16 <i>Petit Ballon Blanc Producteurs Plaimont IGP Cotes de Gascogne 2017</i> Starbright, pale yellow colour with flavours of lemon, green apple and hints of stone fruit. Gascony's hallmark fine acidity and refreshment all at play in this vibrant white. (VG)</p> <p>17 <i>Panul Sauvignon Blanc Vinedos Marchigue Chile 2017</i> This aromatic Sauvignon Blanc shows fresh, tropical and citrus aromas and flavours with additional bright, grassy notes on the palate. (VG)</p> <p>18 <i>Sanziana Pinot Grigio Recas Cramele 2017</i> Opulent aromas of grapefruit and peach, with fresh flavours of melon, apple and zesty citrus.</p> <p>19 <i>Lowry's Pass Chenin Blanc South Africa 2017</i> A perfect example of South African Chenin Blanc. It is light and zesty and can be enjoyed on its own or with food. Zingy and refreshing with grapefruit, lime and some nettley notes. (V)</p> <p>20 <i>Santa Florentina Organic Chardonnay Fairtrade Argentina 2017</i> The exceptional purity and refreshing flavours of this wine are a hallmark of Argentina's Famatina Valley. The wine carries Fairtrade status. (O,V)</p> <p>21 <i>Ana Sauvignon Blanc New Zealand 2017</i> A typically Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc, with plenty of upfront grass and gooseberries notes . The palate is fresh and clean with characters similar to the nose. Followed by a delicious, persisting finish. (VG)</p> <p>22 <i>Chapel Down Flint Dry</i> Aromas of zesty lemon, fresh green apple, white flowers and green pepper characterise this wine. <p>30 <i>Chablis Domaine Millet 2016</i> Pale lemon in colour, the nose is classic Chablis; stony and mineral but also lightly hon-eyed and creamy from the ripened fruit. Elegant and austere with crushed sea-shell and stone fruit notes.</p> <p>31 <i>Sancerre Domaine Tissier 2017</i> This small family-run domaine offers a delicate and aromatic expression of Sauvignon Blanc from some of the finest south-facing slopes of the Sancerre commune. (VG)</p> <p>32 <i>Pouilly-Fume Les Chaumiennes A&E Figeat 2017</i> A true classic! Made by family winemakers going back 6 generations. With smoky greengage, grapefruit and nettle on the nose combined with zesty lime, yellow plum and elderflower on the palate, this wine is multi-layered and exceptionally elegant. (VG)</p> <p>33 <i>Veigadares Albarino Adegas Galegas 2013</i> Spicy peach notes and floral aromas make this wine distinctive. <p>50 <i>Champagne Delamotte Brut NV</i> This is a dry and extremely attractive champagne, balanced and elegant. They combine to give a wine of subtle power, appealing freshness, soft curves and a generous palate rich in orchard fruit. (VG)</p> <p>51 <i>Di Maria Prosecco</i> Pale light yellow in colour with fine perlage. Delicately fruity, slightly aromatic bouquet. Well balanced and light body.</p> <p>52 <i>Di Maria Prosecco Rosato</i> Light rose colour. Elegant and intense bouquet.
